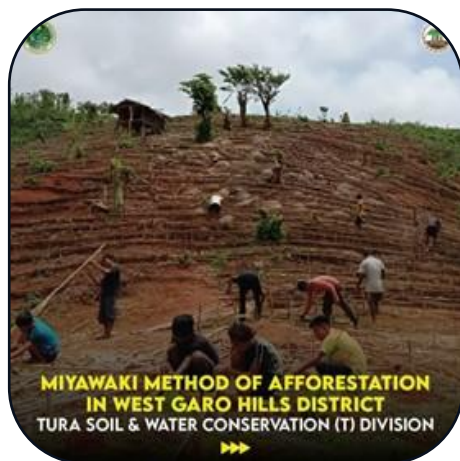
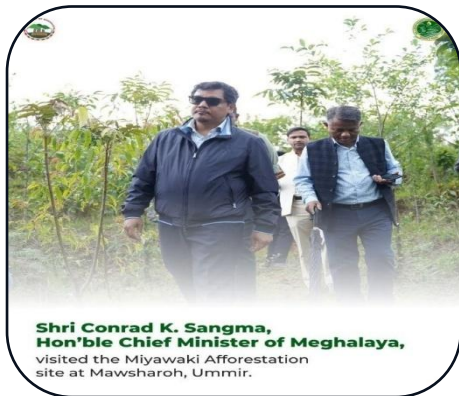

Spearheaded by the Soil and Water Conservation Department, this large-scale initiative aims to boost biodiversity, improve air quality, and combat climate change.
