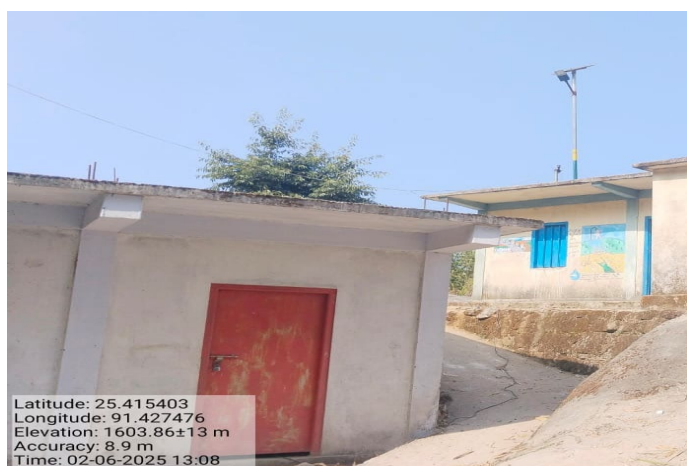

Solar Street light under Entry Point Activity (EPA) at Nonglynkein and Phottdei-Dombahpamum

The Department of Soil & Water Conservation, through the Middle Wahrilang (WDC-3) under the New Generation Watershed Development project had successfully installed the Solar Street light under Entry Point Activity (EPA) Components in villages of Nonglynkein and Phottdei-Dombahpamum transforming the community into improved night-time mobility and safety. 5 nos. of Solar Street light were installed at Nonglynkein at the cost 100615 lakhs and 2 nos. of Solar Street light were installed at Phottdei- DombahPamum at the cost 0.66416 lakhs. These Solar Street Light support the community during evening gatherings or meetings, also the village market opens longer than before which serves as indirect boost in livelihoods.

The advantages of Solar Street Light is that they do not requires any electricity from the main grid since the power is entirely from sunlight. The community does not have to pay any electric bills. This make cost-effective solution especially for rural villages where access to electricity can be limited.
